FAIR PLAY CODE FOR KINGSTON UNITED SOCCER CLUB (KUSC)

FOR COACHES:

1. I will be reasonable when scheduling practices, remembering that young athletes have other interests and obligations.
2. I will teach my athletes to play fairly and to respect the rules, the officials and our opponents.
3. I will ensure that all athletes get equal instruction, support and fair playing time.
4. I will not ridicule, or yell at my athletes for making mistakes or for performing poorly. I will remember that children play to have fun and must be encouraged to have confidence in themselves.
5. I will make sure that equipment and facilities are safe and match the athletes' ages and abilities.
6. I will remember that children need a coach they can respect. I will be generous with praise and set a good example in my dealings with my players, other coaches and game officials.
7. If I disagree with an official, I will discuss the matter calmly either at the half or after the game.
8. I will obtain proper training and continue to upgrade my coaching skills.
9. I will never be alone and out of sight with a player other than my own child (and thus will also never transport a child other than my own child, alone to a Club activity, but may do so if at least my own child is present as well).
10. I will respect and adhere to the Rules and Regulations of the Ontario Soccer Association, the Kingston United Soccer Club, the Club and any League or Tournament (House League or other) in which my team is participating.

I also acknowledge that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned Code, I may be subject to disciplinary action, to be determined by the Club as appropriate.
